ACADEMIC SUCCESS

30% of young people in Baltimore fail to graduate from high school on time.

Club members are 35% more likely to graduate school on time.

GOOD CHARACTER & CITIZENSHIP



35% of high-school youth in Baltimore were involved in a physical fight in the past year.

Club members are 49% more likely to volunteer on a monthly basis, and 26% less likely to get in a physical fight.

HEALTHY LIFESTYLES



33% of young people ages 5-13 in Baltimore are overweight or obese.

80% of Club members ages 9 and older report getting at least an hour of physical activity on five or more days per week.
