Whether you’re leading a workshop, prepping a space for summer camp, or bringing joy through a Club-wide celebration, your team can make a powerful difference.



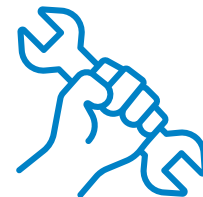
### SCRUB-A-CLUB
